## OPINION

Bibb Stage Line, by the above entitled application, seeks authority to extend its operations in Amador County from the junction of West Point Road and the Mokelumne River to the town of West Point. The latter is a community with an approximate population of 3,500. Its principal industries are lumbering and mining.

Applicant is presently authorized to transport passengers, baggage, and shipments of express weighing 150 pounds or less, on passenger carrying vehicles, between Jackson and certain specified points in Amador County. Decision No. 41085 in Application No. 28943 authorized the transfer and sale of the operative rights of P. J. Bibb, granted in Decision No. 40255, as amended by Decision No. 40964, in Application No. 28025, to the Bibb Stage Line, a corporation, the applicant in this proceeding.

No common carrier service is available to or from this community and the people are wholly dependent upon private means of transportation.

Applicant proposes a scheduled service of two round trips each day to West Point, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

Exhibit "B" attached to the application indicates a reduction in the fares. The presently effective fares approximate

six cents per mile, those proposed are about four cents per mile.

This service traverses roads through hilly and mountainous country.

After a full review of the facts of record the Commission is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of this application. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

It is considered desirable to issue a new certificate, combining the existing operative rights with the extension applied for in this application.

## ORDER

The above entitled application having been filed, the Commission being fully informed, and having found that public convenience and necessity so require,

## IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to the Bibb Stage Line, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and shipments of express weighing 150 pounds, or less, on passenger carrying vehicles between Jackson, Martell, Electra Power House, Pine Grove, Pioneer Station, West Point, Buckhorn, Bartons, Tiger Creek, Salt Springs, the various construction camps on the Mokelumne River Hydro-Electric Development Project and intermediate points subject to the following conditions:

and sold to Bibb Stage Line, a corporation, pursuant to Decision No. 41085 in Application No. 28943, be and it is hereby revoked and annulled.
