<u>OPINION</u>

By this application ban Diego Electric Reilway Company requests permission to establish bus service over a feeder route supplementary to applicant's Ocean Beach Line (Route "O") in the City of San Diego. The proposed route lies entirely within applicant's third fare zone and will be incorporated into presently established zone system fares.

Applicant alleges that the area proposed to be served is a rapidly growing territory which is not now receiving adequate service. The new service vill provide essential transportation for residents of the district and in addition will fill a need for transportation to and from the Richard Dana Junior High School.

Upon full consideration of the application, it appears that the establishment of the proposed route will be in the public interest and the application will accordingly be granted. It will suffice to amend the service regulations of a previous order (Decision No. 37737 in Application No. 26570) by providing an additional route to be incorporated in the description of applicant's Route "O" defined in that decision. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Application therefor having been filed and considered, and the Commission now being fully advised,

IT IS CROMMED that the description of applicant's Route "O",

appearing on Sheet 6 of Decision No. 37737 in Application No. 26570, be and it is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph thereto:

> "Together with the following described route: Commencing at the entrance of the United States Naval Electronics Laboratory on Catalina Boulevard; thence along Catalina Boulevard to Voltaire Street; thence along Voltaire Street to Poinsettia Drive; thence along Poinsettia Drive to Chatsworth Boulevard; thence along Chatsworth Boulevard to the Richard Dana Junior High School at Narragansett Avenue; with permission to turn its motor vehicles at termini or intermediate points by operating around a block in either direction or in accordance with local traffic rules."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall comply with the rules of the Commission's General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission within 60 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public.
