Good Cause Appearing IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to permanently replace the Standard No. 5 crossing signals at the crossing of Garvey Boulevard and its Bassett Branch (Crossing No. 6T-19.58-C) with two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. 0. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
