TENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

C. A. Worth & Co. transports drugs, drug sundries and liquors for Coffin-Redington Company within San Francisco and from San Francisco to East Bay points. Prior orders in this proceeding have authorized observance of the monthly San Francisco drayage rates in connection with both the local drayage and transbay operations. This authority is scheduled to expire October 10, 1948. Its indefinite extension is now sought.

The verified supplemental application shows that transbay and local drayage shipments are transported by the same equipment units and that under the circumstances it is not feasible to segregate the charges. It also shows that the rates proposed to be applied to the transbay traffic include the drayage rate increases which became effective July 6, 1948, and thus reflect higher costs of operation experienced since this matter was last considered a year ago.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the authority in question should be extended. Because the conditions under which the service is provided may change at any time, the extension will be limited to a period of one year and will be made subject to such earlier

modification or further extension as may become necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 40807 of October 10, 1947, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby amended by substituting in the first ordering paragraph thereof "Item No. 570-series of San Francisco City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A" for "Item No. 810-series of San Francisco City Carriers' Tariff No. 1"; and that the expiration date of the authority granted by said Decision No. 40807, as amended herein, be and it is hereby extended to October 10, 1949, unless sooner changed or extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective October 10, 1948.
