## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission by Decision No. 42071, dated September 21, 1948, authorized Pacific Gas and Electric Company to issue and sell \$75,000,000 principal amount of its First and Refunding Mortgage Bonds, Series R, due June 1, 1982, subject to the condition that the authority so granted will become effective when the Commission has entered a supplemental order fixing the price at which Pacific Gas and Electric Company may sell said Series R bonds and when the company has paid the fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act. Such fee was paid on September 22, 1948.

Applicant has advised the Commission that it has accepted a bid of 100.03999% of the principal amount of said bonds, plus interest thereon from June 1, 1948, to the date of payment and delivery, and that said bonds will bear interest at the rate of 3-1/8% per annum, payable semi-annually. Applicant asks permission to sell said bonds at that price.
