## OPINION AND ORDER

Mitchell Silliman Company, a corporation engaged, among other things, in the public utility warehouse business in ; Salinus Valley, has applied to the Public Utilities Commission for permission to execute a deed of trust and a mortgage of chattels and to issue a note in the principal amount of \$50,000, payable in annual installments over a period of ten years with interest at the rate of 5% per annum, for the purpose of financing, in part, the cost of improvements to its properties.

It appears that Mitchell Silliman Company operates public warehouses at Salinas, Chualar and Camphora for the storage of beans and grain in sacks. It now reports the necessity of modernizing its facilities so as to permit the storage of commodities in bulk. The estimated cost of thus modernizing its facilities is stated at \$85,000, of which \$50,000 will be paid or provided through the issue of the note referred to herein.

The Commission has considered this application and is of the opinion that a public hearing thereon is not necessary, that the application should be granted, as herein provided, and Dated at San Francisco, California, this 17th day of October, 1948.
