OPINION AND ORDER

In this application Sierra Pipe Line Company requests authorization to abandon a pumping plant in the Elk Hills area and the initial 2.38 miles of 60-mile pipe line extending from this pumping plant. This pipe line system is leased from The Texas Company and is used for the transportation of crude oil.

Applicant states that the pipe line system was operated by it from February 1, 1945 to September 26, 1945 at which time the U.S. Elk Hills Naval Petroleum Reserve was shut in. Applicant further states that the pipe line facilities have not been used since August 29, 1945.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant, and being of the opinion that the application should be granted, that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary, and good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sierra Pipe Line Company is authorized to abandon the pumping plant located in Section 21, Township 31 South, Range 24 East, N.D.D. & H., and that portion of the ten-inch pipe line extending from this pump station westerly a distance of approximately 2.38 miles.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
