THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

ORIGINAL

Prior orders in this proceeding have authorized applicant to deviate from the minimum rates applicable to the transportation of iron and steel structural materials and babbitt metal. The transportation service involved is that performed for Joseph T. Ryerson & Son, Inc. between its Los Angeles County plant and points in Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego Counties. The authority is scheduled to expire on November 1, 1943. A one-year extension on a modified basis is now sought.

The verified supplemental application shows that there has been no substantial change in the general conditions under which the transportation service in question is performed since this matter was considered a year ago; that the authority now outstanding permits the use of the Los Angeles drayage rates then in effect; that these drayage rates were subsequently increased; that corresponding increases are here proposed; and that these higher rates may reasonably be expected to produce a satisfactory profit.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the granting of the sought authority is justified. The order will be made effective November 1, 1943, so that there will be no lapse in the authority.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Appendix "A" to Decision No. 40388 of June 10, 1947, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby further amended by substituting the following rates for those named in Columns A, B and C thereof:


