ORDER

Contra Costa County is authorized to widen the existing crossings at grade of Chesley Avenue with tracks of The Atchison, Topula & Santa Fe Railway Company and Southern Pacific Company mear Richmond in said County (Crossings No. 2-1187.9 and No. A-16.3). Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of outer rails. The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company and Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing with their respective tracks between such lines. Width of crossings and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No.72. Protection shall be by existing standard crossing signs and signals which may be moved to new locations.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
