ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authcrized to construct a wyo track at grade across "B" Street in Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing Nc. 61-2.13-C. Said track connects tracks of applicant with trackage of Contral California Traction Company. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to 10 the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the readway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. tection shall be; by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Upon completion, an existing crossing with "B" Street, located approximately 200 feet southerly (Crossing No. 61-2.17-C), shall be removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
