O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to install two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals at the crossing of Hampton Road with its main line track in Alameda County (Crossing No. 4-18.7), said installation to conform with the requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 75-B, and in addition, may be equipped with signs reading "STOP ON RED SIGNAL". The cost of installation of said signals shall be borne in accordance with agreement between applicant and the County of Alameda. Maintenance costs shall be borne by applicant.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
