## O P I N I O N

Archie W. Jackson, doing business as Jackson Lines, was granted a certificate authorizing the transportation of passengers, baggage and shipments of express weighing 100 pounds or less between Fresno and Tranquillity and intermediate points, via Raisin City. (Decision No. 41393, dated March 30, 1948, Application No. 29099)

In this proceeding applicant Jackson requests authority to discontinue and abandon that service. As justification therefor, applicant states that he has conducted a daily service between those points since May 3, 1948; that he has solicited business by advertising the service in newspapers published at various points served and the posting of notices and signs along the route; that in spite of these efforts less than six passengers daily on the average have used applicant's service; that the total revenues and expenses from the operation since its inception on May 3, 1948, have amounted to \$1,019.66 and \$1,406.11, respectively, and that the expenses of operation do not include any allowances for salary to applicant.

After full consideration of the evidence of record it is our conclusion and we find that applicant's request to discontinue passenger stage service between Fresno and Tranquillity and intermediate points has been justified and will be authorized. No public hearing is necessary.

An application therefor having been filed and it having been found that the service provided by applicant is no longer required, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Archie W. Jackson is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon passenger stage service between Fresno and Tranquillity and intermediate points and the operative right therefor heretofore granted by Decision No. 41393 is hereby revoked and annulled.

(2) That all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Archie W. Jackson are hereby cancelled:

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
