ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across Damon Street in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BG-486.52-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that bids for construction of the track and the building to be served are subject to revision unless work is under way on or before November 30, 1948, and applicant requests that 20-day effective date provision be waived.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
