The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company has filed an application with this Commission for an order abolishing the crossing of "D" Street with its main lines and yard tracks in the City of Bakersfield, Crossing No. 2-887.7.

The City of Bakersfield has indicated its consent to the closing of this crossing and

Good Cause Appearing IT IS ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abolish by physical closing the crossing of "D" Street with its tracks in the City of Bakersfield, as shown on Exhibit "A", attached to the Application. The entire expense of removal of said crossing shall be borne by applicant.

Within thirty days after completion of the abandonment herein authorized applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
