ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Complainant herein alleges that on October 3, 1948, defendant curtailed the hours of service on its No. 70 line, serving the Rockridge-Claremont area. Shortly after service of the complaint, and on November 18, 1948, complainant filed a motion to dismiss. It is stated therein that defendant has proposed to commence a substituted service on November 28, 1948, by rerouting the No. 17 Alcatraz bus line, and to provide forty-minute service throughout each week day and Saturday and Sunday during the hours service was furnished by the No. 70 line before October 1, 1948. With the understanding that such service will be rendered, the complaint appears to be satisfied, and Case No. 4980 is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
