ELEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant has requested renewal of his license to engage in business as a motor transportation broker at 655 Peralta Avenue in Oakland. The license was originally issued by Decision No. 39237, dated July 30, 1946, and has since been renewed and reissued. (Decisions Nos. 39757, 40416, 41122.) The current license period expires December 31, 1948.

The license will be renewed. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the application of Blake W. Palamountain for renewal of his license as a motor transportation broker, as defined in Chapter 705, Statutes of 1935, be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. That said licensee shall keep his license certificate as a motor transportation broker open at all times to public inspection.
2. That said licensee shall do business as a motor transportation broker only at the location set forth in his application herein for renewal of his license, and for the motor carriers named in Decision No. 40416 herein, or for whom he may hereafter from time to time be permitted to do business by any subsequent order or orders of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commission issue and deliver to applicant a license certificate as such motor

transportation broker in the form heretofore adopted by the Commission for such license certificate, and subject to the conditions hereinabove specified.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
