## <u>ORDER</u>

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct one additional side track at grade across 12th Avenue in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-136.0. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by existing standard crossing signs and signals. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Cars shall not be stored or allowed to stand on said track within a distance of 200 feet from the center line of 12th Avenue at any time that a train is approaching said 12th Avenue on the adjacent main line track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
