SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The original Decision No. 41298, in these proceedings, issued on the 9th day of March, 1948, among other things, directed Arenal Water Company to install certain improvements to provide adequate water service to its consumers in Stinson Beach and vicinity in Marin County and furthermore prohibited extension of water service into additional and adjacent territory until such improvements in water supply and service had been completed. Thereafter this Commission issued its First Supplemental Order in Decision No. 41648,

on the 25th day of May, 1948, in which it found that the improvements as ordered in said decision had been completed and were in operation in a manner satisfactory to and approved by this Commission.

There is now pending before this Commission Application No. 29790, being a petition filed by Arenal Water Company for the approval of certain agreements with William Kent Estate Co. which, among other things, provide for the extension of public utility water service into certain subdivided and other properties owned by said Estate Co. Investigation having been made and it now appearing that the limitations prescribed by this Commission in Decision No. 41298, restricting extension of water service into additional and adjacent territory, are no longer necessary nor proper and should be removed; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all restrictions contained in Decision No. 41298, relating to the extension of water service by Arenal Water Company into territory additional and adjacent to the presently served area of this utility be and they are hereby vacated and removed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
