ORDER

In this application Bucksport & Elk River Railway Company requests permission to abandon that portion of its line of railroad in Humboldt County approximately one and a half miles in length extending from North Fork Frog to the end of the line at Falk.

The application states that the trackage it is proposed to abandon has not been used for approximately thirteen years; that it formerly served a mill of the Elk River Mill and Lumber Company located at Falk but this lumber company has abandoned its operations at Falk and the mill has not been operated for a great many years, and that the Elk River Mill and Lumber Company has agreed to the proposed abandonment.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary on this matter; and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Bucksport & Elk River Railway Company is authorized to abandon and remove that portion of its line of railroad in Humboldt County, extending from Engineer's Station 352+18 to Engineer's Station 432+15 and to cancel all tariffs and schedules appertaining thereto.

Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if

above conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
