IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION of CITIZENS DOMESTIC WATER COMPANY FOR AUTHORITY TO INCREASE ITS RATES.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission in its Decision No. 42308, dated December 14, 1948, authorized Citizens Domestic Water Company to increase its rates for water service rendered on and after February 1, 1949, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that those portions of Schedule No. 1 and Schedule No. 2 under "Monthly Minimum Charges" which read:

"For 3/8 x 3/4-inch meter.....\$1.85,"

be and they are hereby amended to read:

For 5/8 x 3/4-inch meter.....\$1.85,

and the monthly minimum charge of \$2.00 for 3/4-inch meters is hereby eliminated from both schedules.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the schedule of rates established in the above-mentioned decision shall become effective for service rendered on and after February 15, 1949, instead of February 1, 1949 as set forth in said Decision No. 42308.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said Decision No. 42308 shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
