FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Bibb Stage Line requests an order authorizing it to change its service between Jackson, Pine Grove, Pioneer Station, West Point and intermediate points from a "scheduled" to an "on-call" basis.

It appears that due to the closing down of mining operations at West Point and some 22 saw mills in the area involved there is no present public demand for service between the above-mentioned points.

Applicant's service between the remaining points covered in the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in Decision No. 42025 (Application No. 29602) was authorized on an "on-call" basis.

From the facts of record we conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that subparagraphs (a) and (b) of Paragraph (1) of the order contained in Decision No. 42025 are hereby deleted therefrom, and the following paragraph is hereby substituted in the place thereto:

"The service between all points shall be on an "on-call" basis, said "on-call" service to be rendered only when not less than seven fares in one direction are offered to applicant, provided that less than seven persons may receive service by payment of the equivalent of the seven fares."

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
