O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of Eighth Street in Richmond, Contra Costa County, substantially at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that Eighth Street is not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening. This order shall not be considered as authorizing deviation from any requirement of this Commission's General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
