OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding Key System Transit Lines requests a certificate authorizing it to extend passenger stage service a distance of about one-half mile along Bancroft Avenue between its junction with Sybil Avenue, in the City of San Leandro, and its junction with 138th Avenue in Alameda County. Applicant would operate its No. 43 Foothill Boulevard Line over the proposed route for the purpose of serving a new school known as the San Leandro Junior High School. The proposed service has been requested by the principal of that school, which is without public transportation. Applicant's present zone system fares would be applicable to the proposed service.

After full consideration of the evidence of record, it is our conclusion that public convenience and necessity require the proposed service, which will be authorized. No public hearing is necessary. Therefore and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Key System Transit Lines, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 2½ of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers between the

junction of Bancroft Avenue and Sybil Avenue, in the City of San Leandro, and the junction of Bancroft Avenue and 138th Avenue, in Alameda County, and intermediate points over and along Bancroft Avenue, looping 138th Avenue, East 14th Street and 136th Avenue to Bancroft Avenue, as an extension and enlargement of and consolidated with the operative right created by Decision No. 38795. Applicant may discontinue operations over a loop along Elsie Avenue, San Jose Street and Sybil Avenue between the junctions of Elsie Avenue and Sybil Avenue with Bancroft Avenue.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted and establish the service within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
