FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

E. A. Hosmer, having on December 28, 1948, filed his First Supplemental Application herein, asking that the Commission authorize a period of ninety (90) days from January 1, 1949 for the filing of the journal entries required by the order in Decision No. 42111, it appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that said First Supplemental Application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 42111, dated October 11, 1948, is amended as follows:

The second condition of the order, which reads:

"2. Within sixty (60) days after the sale of said telephone properties, E. A. Hosmer shall file with the Commission a copy of the bill of sale under which he holds title to said properties, and shall also file with the Commission for its approval copies of journal entries required by the uniform system of accounts prescribed by the Commission for Class C telephone companies."

shall be amended to read as follows:

2. Within sixty (60) days after the sale of said telephone properties, E. A. Hosmer shall file with the Commission a copy of the bill of sale under which he holds title to said properties, and shall also file with the Commission for its approval, not later than March 31, 1949, copies of journal entries required by the uniform system of accounts prescribed by the Commission for Class C telephone companies.

In all other respects Decision No. 42111 shall remain in full force and effect.
