In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of industrial drill track across East Grand Avenue, in the City of South San Francisco, County of San Mateo, State of California.

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional side track at grade across East Grand Avenue in South San Francisco, San Mateo County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-10.4-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Traffic on Grand Avenue shall be protected against train movements by flagging. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

der, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public conventence, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
