O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct two spur tracks and one side track at grade across Jackson Street (Crossing No. D-7.0) and to relocate an existing track at grade across Madison Street (Crossing No. D-7.1) in Oakland, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of the above numbered crossings. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. One crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B), and crossing watchman. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

One existing spur track crossing Jackson Street shall be removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
