FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Under the authority granted by Decision No. 39609, dated November 4, 1946, Pacific Gas and Electric Company acquired from Clyde Henry an electric generating and distribution system at Covelo and a line constructed between Covelo and Longvale. The opinion in said decision states, in part, that ". . . Pacific will be expected to submit for approval the book entries it proposes to make for the purpose of recording the entire transaction, and at that time a further hearing, if required, can be had upon that issue".

On December 16, 1947, Pacific Gas and Electric Company filed its journal entries to record the purchase of the properties which entries show that it paid, in the aggregate, for such properties, the sum of \$110,311.52. A summary distribution of the purchase price is reported as follows:

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a further hearing is not necessary and that the entries should be approved; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Public Utilities Commission hereby approves the journal entries filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company on December 16, 1947, to record the purchase from Clyde Henry of the Covelo properties referred to herein, and the distribution of the purchase price. The approval herein given is for accounting purposes only and shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of said properties.
