O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate a spur track at grade across North Point Street in San Francisco, to the location described in the application. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Relocation of said track is required in connection with construction of a sewage disposal plant by the City and County of San Francisco, and to prevent interference with such construction, applicant has requested waiver of the twenty days effective date condition.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
