SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 42321, dated December 14, 1948, among other things grants Pacific Electric Railway Company until March 1, 1949 to comply with certain provisions as set forth in Decision No. 33088 and Decision No. 41152 respectively in the matters referred to above.

Pacific Electric now requests that it be granted until January 30, 1950 in which to comply with Recommendations Nos. 10 and 38, as set forth in said Decision No. 41152.

Recommendation No. 10 provides that the company shall "Relocate, wherever possible, all passenger landings along tracks in private right of way at highway crossings to the far side of the said crossings."

Recommendation No. 38 provides that the company shall "construct a suitable bus garage at Ocean Park."

It appears that Pacific Electric Railway Company's request for an extension of time in which to comply with Recommendation Nos. 10 and 38 respectively should be treated in the same manner as the company's request for further extension of time in which to comply with other recommendations set forth in Decision No. 41152, as provided for in said Decision No. 42321, to the effect that the time

limit for compliance with those recommendations was extended to March 1, 1949. Accordingly this will be the order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is granted an extension of time until ~~January 30, 1950~~ <sup>March 1, 1949</sup> in which to comply with the provisions of the following Recommendations Nos. 10 and 38, as set forth in Decision No. 41152.

In all other respects the application involved herein is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
