O P I N I O N

By this application, Landier Transit Company, Inc., seeks to modify its East Imperial Route for the reasons, as stated, that part of the present route is impassable during inclement weather, and in order to more adequately serve the territory.

Applicant alleges that the City of Los Angeles has granted it a temporary permit to operate in accordance with its present application. The application further contains a statement that the only other common carrier operating in the vicinity is the Pacific Electric Railway Company. Said company has advised the Commission that it has no objection to the granting of this application.

No changes in fares or schedules are involved and the proposed modification appears to be in the public interest and the application will accordingly be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

An application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and it being found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the description of East Imperial Line contained in Ordering Paragraph numbered (2) of Decision No. 41286, be hereby amended to read as follows:

"From Graham Avenue along 103rd Street, Wilmington Avenue, 112th Street, paved street within Imperial Courts, Santa Ana Boulevard, Watts Avenue, Imperial Highway, Croesus Avenue, 114th Street, Wilmington Avenue, Santa Ana Boulevard north of Pacific Electric tracks, Graham Avenue to 103rd Street."

(2) That Decision No. 41286, as heretofore amended, shall, in all other respects, remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
