## SUFFLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

This proceeding involves rates for the transportation of property for General Mills, Inc. - Sperry Division, between points in southern California. By virtue of prior orders, applicant has been authorized to deviate from the minimum rates otherwise applicable to this service. The authority is scheduled to expire May 11, 1949. A one-year extension is now sought.

The verified supplemental application shows that the circumstances and conditions which have justified deviation from the minimum rates continue to prevail and that the traffic involved has been handled on a profitable basis under the authorized rates.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the granting of the sought extension is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority heretofore granted Ira F. Lamb in this proceeding be and it is hereby extended to May 11, 1950, unless sooner changed, cancelled or further extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
