O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Calvada during the past two years and that continued maintenance thereof as a freight station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Calvada, County of Sierra, as a station at which freight will not be handled and to cancel all freight tariffs and schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after reclassification as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
