## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC )  
 COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction ) Application  
 at grade of industrial spur track across Dolan ) No. 30141  
 Road in the County of Monterey, State of California.)

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Dolan Road near Castroville, Monterey County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-109.0-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 4 per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Applicant alleges that the industry for which the track is to be constructed now has a contractor on the ground and requests that the order be made effective on the date of this order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
