ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Santa Monica Boulevard and Mansfield Avenue in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6HA-7.72C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 2%. Protection shall consist of one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
