O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate a branch main track at grade across San Pedro Street in San Jose, Santa Clara County, to the location described in the application. Said track crossing is identified as a portion of Crossing No. DA-46.7. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) and crossing watchman. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
