ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By its application in this proceeding, Inter-Urban Express Corporation sought a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operation as a highway common carrier between Martinez and Antioch, and intermediate points, as an extension of its existing service. Following a public hearing, the matter was dismissed without prejudice by Decision No. 36634, rendered herein September 28, 1943. Subsequently, at applicant's instance, this proceeding was reopened for further hearing by order dated October 21, 1947. Pursuant to this order, the matter was heard at San Francisco on December 15, 1947, when it was continued to a later date, and subsequently was dropped from the calendar at applicant's suggestion. Applicant now requests that this proceeding be dismissed, without prejudice, however, to the filing of a new application. An order will be entered accordingly.

O R D E R

Application as above-entitled having been filed, a public hearing having been held therein, applicant having requested the dismissal of said proceeding, and the Commission being now fully advised:

IT IS ORDERED, that the above-entitled proceeding be, and

it hereby is, dismissed without prejudice to the filing of a new application by applicant, for a certificate similar to that originally sought by the application herein.
