ORDER IN APPLICATION NO. 30209 AND
SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER IN APPLICATION NO. 29150

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across South King Street near Bakersfield, Kern County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BT-315.8. The crossing of South King Street heretofore authorized in Decision No. 41558, Application No. 29150, shall also be identified as Crossing No. BT-315.8 in lieu of the number assigned in said Decision. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that South King Street is now being paved at the point of crossing and as applicant desires to lay its track before such paving is completed, it is requested that this order be made effective on this date.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or
safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
