O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a passing track at grade across county road near Madera, Madera County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-1018.3. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

When said passing track is occupied by a train for the purpose of meeting or permitting another train to pass on the adjacent main line track and any portion of said train stands less than 300 feet from the crossing but not blocking the roadway, traffic on the county road shall be protected by a member of the crew acting as a flagman.

Before constructing said crossing applicant shall file permit or other evidence of the consent of Madera County to said crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
