## ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

Irvin Millstone having filed verified complaints alleging in substance that his telephone service at 2319 Brooklyn Avenue, Los Angeles, California, under numbers Angelus 10772 and Angelus 39043, has been disconnected by defendant; that said communication facilities were not used as an instrumentality to violate the law nor in aiding or abetting such violation, but were in fact used for conducting his barber business; and that irreparable injury and great hardship will result unless said service is restored pending hearing and decision on the complaints; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company

is hereby directed to restore telephone service to complainant pending a hearing on said complaints and further Commission order thereon. The complaints, assigned to Commissioner Huls, are set for hearing before Examiner Syphers or such other Examiner as may hereafter be designated, at 9:30 o'clock a.m. on Monday, June 13, 1949, in the Commission Court Room, Ninth Floor, The Mirror Building, Los Angeles, California.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order, together with copies of the complaints herein, to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, at least ten (10) days before the above date of hearing, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply to said complaints within ten (10) days after such service. The Secretary is directed further to cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant at least ten (10) days before the above hearing.
