ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

Bob B. Levy having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that his telephone service at 172 North Formosa Avenue, Los Angeles, California, under number YOrk 5550, has been disconnected by defendant; that said service was not used as an instrumentality, directly or indirectly, to violate or aid and abet the violation of the law; and that great and irreparable damage will result unless said service is restored pending hearing and decision on the complaint; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby directed to restore telephone service to complainant pending a hearing on said complaint and further Commission order thereon. The complaint, assigned to Commissioner Huls, is set for hearing before Examiner Syphers or such other Examiner as may hereafter be designated, at 1:30 o'clock p.m. on Wednesday, June 15, 1949, in the Commission Court Room, Ninth Floor, The Mirror Building, Los Angeles, California.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this or-

der, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, at least ten (10) days before the above date of hearing, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply to said complaint within ten (10) days after such service. The Secretary is directed further to cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant at least ten (10) days before the above hearing.
