ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

Harry Talsky and Millie Talsky having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that their telephone service at 528 $\frac{1}{2}$ South Soto, Los Angeles, California, under number ANGelus 1-9856, has been disconnected by defendant without any reason, justification or cause; and that grave hardship will result unless said service is restored pending hearing and decision on the complaint; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby directed to restore telephone service to complainants pending a hearing on said complaint and further Commission order thereon. The complaint, assigned to Commissioner Huls, is set for hearing before Examiner Syphers or such other Examiner as may hereafter be designated, at 9:30 a.m., Thursday, June 16, 1949, in the Commission Court Room, Ninth Floor, The Mirror Building, 145 South Spring Street, Los Angeles, California.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, at least ten (10) days

before the above date of hearing, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply to said complaint within ten (10) days after such service. The Secretary is directed further to cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainants at least ten (10) days before the above hearing.
