SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

City Carriers' Tariff No. 6 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 names minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of specified materials, including asphaltic concrete, cold road oil mixture, crushed rock and gravel, in dump trucks. Zone rates are provided between specified production areas and delivery zones in Los Angeles and Orange counties. Milage rates apply between points in these counties not covered by the zoning arrangements.

Sparks-Mundo, a partnership consisting of C. O. Sparks, Inc. and Mundo Engineering Company, is engaged in producing, manufacturing and distributing asphaltic concrete and cold road oil mixture. Its principal facilities are located in Los Angeles County Production Area "S". Arthur H. Geisler, doing business as Geisler Construction Co., produces and distributes crushed rock and gravel. He is developing facilities in the vicinity of Interval and Hollingsworth Drives in Los Angeles County and not within any of the producing areas specified in the dump truck tariff. By petition filed April 7, 1949, Sparks-Mundo and Geisler seek enlargement of the zone rate structure.

Sparks-Mundo represents that there is a considerable demand in Orange County for the materials it produces. It asserts that

it is deprived of an opportunity to compete for this business because of the differences between the mileage rates applicable from its plant and the zone rates applicable from its competitors' plants. It urges that zone rates on the same basis as other such rates be established for movements from its plant to competitive territory in Orange County.

Geisler represents that his new facilities will produce substantial quantities of crushed rock and gravel and that zone rates comparable to those maintained from other producing areas are required for the distribution of these materials to various Los Angeles County points.

Interested carriers and shippers have been notified of the filing of this petition. California Dump Truck Owners Association has supported and no one has opposed its being granted.

Petitioners have shown that they are disadvantaged by the availability of zone rates from competitors' plants and not from theirs. The proposed extensions of the zone rate system have been justified and will be established.

The 5 per cent general increase in zone and mileage rates prescribed by Decision No. 42479 of February 1, 1949, in this proceeding, was promulgated in Supplement No. 7 to the dump truck tariff. In view of the extensive revision of tariff pages required in connection with the zone rate revision found justified herein, it is advisable to incorporate the general increase in all of the pages affected.

A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 6 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566, as amended, in Cases Nos. 4246 and 4434) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein the supplement and revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which supplement and pages are numbered as follows:
