O R D E R

Glenn E. Coolidge is authorized to construct a crossing at grade with tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Felton, Santa Cruz County, at the location shown on that certain map and exhibit referred to in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance cost. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach conforming with those shown on said map. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) and by human flagman during times that said crossing is in use for the purpose set forth herein.

This authority is granted with the express condition that said crossing shall be used only as a means of access and egress to a pageant to be held on property of applicant on May 7, 8, 14, 15, 21 and 22, 1949, and that upon completion of said pageant said crossing shall be removed or barricaded in such a manner that the traveling public cannot have access thereto.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
