O R D E R

The City of Torrance is authorized to construct 223rd Street at grade across the Torrance line of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6RCA-18.79-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on the plan (Exhibit "A") accompanying the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
