In the matter of application of SOUTYERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of track extension, necessitating relocation of existing track, in Bluxome Street between Fourth and Fifth Streets, in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California.

## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate a spur track at grade across Bluxome Street in San Francisco, to the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-O. 48-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised with one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

By Supplement to Application applicant has requested that this order be made effective on its date alleging that the operation

of the industry to be served will be seriously delayed if construction of this crossing is unnecessarily delayed, therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
