ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing that Decision No. 36659, in Application No. 25798, authorized Glenn Wright and A. R. Wright, co-partners, doing business as Hunter Liggett Stages, to operate a passenger stage service between San Miguel and King City and intermediate points, via Bradley, Camp Pleyto, and Camp Jolon, designed to meet the needs of military forces between Hunter Liggett Military Reservation and San Miguel, Bradley, and King City; it further appearing that on August 1, 1944, all troops were transferred from the reservation and that temporary suspension of the service was authorized by Decision No. 37322 in Application No. 26301 until December 15, 1944, and thereafter successively continued in effect until December 31, 1946; and it further appearing that no application for further

suspension of said operations has been made to this Commission since December 31, 1946, and that none has been granted by this Commission; and it further appearing that recent investigations by the Commission's staff disclose that all transportation services ceased as of October 1, 1946, and that no operations whatsoever have been conducted under the aforesaid operative right since December 31, 1946, as evidenced by the following letter, to-wit:

"San Jose, California  
April 30, 1949

"Addressed to the Public Utilities Commission,  
State of California:

"I hereby certify that the passenger stage service authorized by the above governing State Body to be inactive, and that services in connection therewith terminated on October 1 1946.

"I, A. R. Wright, in behalf of my brother and myself, do hereby state that no operations were conducted subsequent to date of December 31, 1946 -- and that resumption of service is definitely not contemplated.

Therefore, good cause appearing, it is found that the said Glenn Wright and A. R. Wright, co-partners, doing business as Hunter Liggett Stages, are no longer conducting and (with no intention of ever resuming such services and operations) have discontinued, without the authority of the Commission, all of the aforesaid passenger stage operations to, from, or between the several points and territories hereinbefore referred to, thereby resulting in abandonment of said operative right.

IT IS ORDERED that the above-mentioned entire operative right of said Glenn Wright and A. R. Wright, co-partners, doing business as Hunter Liggett Stages, to, from, or between the several points and territories, as aforesaid, be and the same is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and time tables on file are

hereby cancelled and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof in the manner provided by law, unless the said Glenn Wright and A. R. Wright, or either of them, before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order, denying the statements set forth herein and requesting public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until hearing is had and further order is issued.
