O R D E R

Modesto Interurban Railway operated by Modesto and Empire Traction Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Sierra Avenue near Modesto, Stanislaus County, at the location indicated on the map accompanying the application as the location of the most easterly of the three tracks crossing said Sierra Avenue. Said crossing shall be identified as Crossing No. 28-1.05-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
