O P I N I O N

In this proceeding, Fresno City Lines, Inc., requests the Commission to issue to it a new certificate of public convenience and necessity in the place and stead of all those certificates which applicant presently holds. The purpose is to include in one certificate all passenger stage operative rights of applicant which would supersede rights created by some 27 decisions.

Applicant conducts a passenger stage service within the City of Fresno serving the City and several adjacent areas including Pinedale and Fig Gardens. This service is provided pursuant to numerous certificates granted to it or its predecessors in interest. There is no proposal to extend, discontinue or change any of the routes which applicant is authorized to use, nor would fares or service be affected. All the existing operative rights would be revoked and annulled. No other common carrier would be affected by applicant's proposal and no public hearing appears to be necessary. After full consideration of the evidence of record, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted.

O R D E R

An application for a new certificate in the place and stead of all operative rights presently held by applicant having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and it having been found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Fresno City Lines, Inc., authorizing operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers within the City of Fresno and between the City of Fresno, Pinedale, Fig Gardens, Mayfair Tract, Sierra Vista, County Fair Grounds, Hazelwood and intermediate points.

(2) That applicant is authorized to turn its motor vehicles at termini or en route either in the intersection of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to street intersections provided that municipal traffic regulations are observed.

(3) That all the passenger stage operative rights superseded by the certificate granted herein and which were created by the decisions listed below as well as any other operative rights held by applicant are hereby cancelled, revoked and annulled together with any orders amendatory thereof:

(4) That in conducting passenger stage operations pursuant to the certificate granted by this decision, Fresno City Lines, Inc. shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- a. Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hereof.
- b. Subject to the authority of the Commission to change or modify them by further order, applicant shall conduct operations pursuant to the certificate herein granted over and along the following routes:

Route No. 1

Starting at Wishon Avenue and Clinton Avenue, thence along Clinton Avenue, Del Mar Avenue, Brown Avenue, College Avenue, Fountain Way, Wishon Avenue, Shields Avenue, Wilson Avenue, Clinton Avenue, Wishon Avenue, Olive Avenue, North Fulton Street, Fulton Street, Ventura Street, First Street, Huntington Boulevard, Huntington Avenue, Chestnut Avenue, Ventura Avenue, South 12th Street to Huntington Boulevard.

Route No. 2

Starting at Fresno Street and Kearney Boulevard, thence along Kearney Boulevard, Modoc Street, Merced Street, Irwin Street, California Avenue, Mono Street, Pottle Avenue, Fresno Street, Fresno Avenue, Michigan Avenue, Effie Street and Clinton Street to Fresno Avenue.

Route No. 2-A

Starting at Fresno Street and A Street, thence along A Street, Trinity Street, Amador Street, Modoc Street, Dunn Avenue and D Street to Fresno Street.

Route No. 2-B

Starting at Fresno Avenue and University Avenue, thence along University Avenue, North First Street, Weldon Avenue, Mayfair Drive East, North 6th Street, McKinley Avenue, Millbrook Avenue, Floradora Avenue to Fresno Avenue.

Route No. 3

Starting at San Pablo Avenue and McKinley Avenue, thence along McKinley Avenue, Del Mar Avenue, University Avenue, San Pablo Avenue, Hedges Avenue, Blackstone Avenue, Stanislaus Street to Fulton Street.

Route No. 3-A

Starting at Fresno Street and Belmont Avenue, thence along Belmont Avenue, Millbrook Avenue, Tyler Avenue and North First Street to Belmont Avenue.

Route No. 4

Starting at Fulton Street and Tulare Street, thence along Tulare Street, North Angus Street, Olive Avenue, North 12th Street, Harvey Avenue, North Chestnut Avenue, Olive Avenue, North Sierra Avenue to Harvey Avenue.

Route No. 5

Starting at Harrison Avenue and West Olive Avenue, thence along West Olive Avenue, Vagedes Avenue, Yale Avenue, Harrison Avenue and Belmont Avenue to Blackstone Avenue.

Route No. 5-A

Starting at Tulare Street and East Tulare Street, thence along East Tulare Street, North First Street, McKenzie Avenue, North 12th Street, Illinois Avenue, North Chestnut Avenue, Grant Avenue and North 12th Street to McKenzie Avenue.

Route No. 6

Starting at South 3rd Street and Butler Avenue, thence along Butler Avenue, Chance Avenue, Liberty Avenue, South 10th Street, Lowe Avenue, Orange Avenue, Lowe Avenue, South 3rd Street, Hamilton Avenue, Van Ness Avenue, Los Angeles Street and Fulton Street to Ventura Avenue.

Route No. 6-A

Starting at Fresno Street and C Street, thence along C Street, California Street, Kirk Avenue, Belgravia Avenue and Holly Avenue to California Avenue.

Route No. 7

Starting at Wishon Avenue and University Avenue, thence along University Avenue, Echo Avenue, Van Ness Boulevard, Palm Avenue, Herndon Avenue, Helm Avenue, Mineretts Avenue, Sugar Pine Avenue, Blackstone Avenue, Rialto Avenue to Van Ness Boulevard.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
