The City of San Bernardino is authorized to construct Twenty-Third Street and Twenty-Fifth Street at grade across the Arrowhead Springs line of the Pacific Electric Railway Company at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 6JB-2.67 and 6JB-2.79, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Widths of crossings shall be not less than fifty (50) feet and grades of approach not greater than six (6) per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection at each location shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
