## ELEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants transport lumber and other forest products for the Owens-Farks Lumber Company from Vernon to points within a 30-mile radius of that city. They have been authorized to deviate from the minimum rates for this transportation by prior orders in this proceeding. The authority is scheduled to expire June 26, 1949. A one-year extension is sought.

The verified supplemental application shows that high load factors have been maintained and the volume of traffic has increased since this matter was last considered. It also shows that operations under the authorized rates have been profitable and that these rates may reasonably be expected to be compensatory during the ensuing year.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension is justified and should be granted.


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Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 38032 of June 26, 1945, as

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amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to June 26, 1950, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.
